




1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Odisha Civil Service (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Amendment Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.

2. In the Odisha Civil Service (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1989, after the proviso to rule 2, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

"Provided further that for advertisements made during calendar years 2021, 2022 and 2023, the said upper age limit shall be thirty-eight years."

1. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY:

4. Reservation. :

The Odisha Reservation of Vacancies (In posts and service for ST & SC) Act. 1975 and the Odisha Reservation of Posts & Services for Socially & Educationally Backward Classes Act.2008 and the rules made there under and such other principles of the post based reservation as prescribed by the State Government on the land mark judgement of Hon'ble High Court / Supreme Court from time to time shall be followed.

There shall be reservation of vacancies for woman candidates of respective categories as per Rule. Similarly 4% will be reserved for Physically Handicapped as per the provision of Section – 33 of the "persons with disabilities" (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act). 1% for eminent sports personnel and 3% for Ex – Serviceman.

Instructions contained in SSPED Deptt. Resoluition No. 7140 / Dtd. 05.09.2017 shall be adhered to for (PwDs) candidates.

The PH candidates shall be referred to the Appellate Medical Board constituted by W & CD Departemnt vide Notificaiton No. - 16430 / WCD / Dt. 06.09.2011 for Re-examinaiton. Engagement order shall be issued if such candidates found genuine and eligible by the Board.

6. Selection Procedure. :

All Selection of teaching staffs shall be done through written examination (Multiple Choice Question) comprising or 100 marks **based on OMR**. Eligible candidates who meet all the requisite qualification and criteria shall be shortlisted for appearing in the written examination. The Selection will be made by the District Selection Committee headed by the District Collector, Sundargarh with Inspector of Schools (SSD), Sundargarh and District Welfare Officer, Sundargarh (Member Convenor) as members of the Committee as per Notificaiton No. - S.R.O. No. - 1169 / 93 / Dt. 13.12.1993 of ST & SC Development Department. The Selection Committee shall prepare the list of suitable candidates on the basis of the results of written examination. The names of the candidates shall be arranged according to the marks secured in the written examination. Minimum cut-off mark for UR category is 35 and for Reserved Category is 30 out of the total 100 makrs. Preference will be given to the candidates belonging to the Sundargarh districts. The scheme & syllabus for the written examination for each category of teaching post is enclosed in Annexure-B.

- (i) In case of two or more candidates secured the same marks the candidate older in age will be placed above in the rank.
- (ii) If there is further tie, the higher percentage of marks secured in training qualification will be taken in to account.
- (iii) Higher Education will not be given any weightage during preparation of merit list in all categories.
