Report of the District Level Independent Multidisciplinary Expert Group (DLMEG) for acquisition of Private Land of Ac. 3.18 acre for Land Bank filling by IDCO, Bhubaneswar for extension of industry of M/s Eastern Alloys Pvt. Ltd. in Village Goibhanga in the Lathikata Block of Lathikata Tahasil under Panposh Sub-Division of Sundargarh District

A meeting of the District Level Independent Multidisciplinary Expert Group (DLMEG) was convened as per letter No. 1252, dated. 08. 09. 23 to evaluate the final SIA Study report submitted by NCDS, Bhubaneswar on the acquisition of Ac. 3.18acre of private land for land bank filling by IDCO, Bhubaneswar for extension of industry of M/s Eastern Alloys Pvt. Ltd. in Village Goibhanga in the Lathikata Block of Lathikata Tahasil under Panposh Sub-Division of Sundargarh District. The meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Prof. Ashutosh Naik in the office Chamber of Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh on dated 16.09.23 at 4.00 PM. The meeting was attended by Mr. Abhimanyu Majhi, OAS-S (ADM, Sundargath), Mr. Dasrathi Saraboo, (Sub- Collector, Sadar, Sundargarh and Convenor), Mr. Benedict Lakra, OAS-I(Retd) (Member), Mr. Durgamadhab Patel, OAS-I(Retd) (Member), Ms. Sujata Joypuria, G.M., D.I.C., Mr. Feudi Nand Minz, Sarpanch, Kalunga(Kha), Ms. Khusmarin Tappo, Naib-Sarpanch, Kalunga(Kha) and Ramakanta Mishra. 
At the outset Mr. Majhi, ADM, welcomed all the members of the meeting and narrated the purpose of convening the meeting. Then Prof. Ashutosh Naik, Chairman requested Mr. Ramakanta Mishra, Representative of RICOR to present the summary of the SIA report. He told that detailed door to door survey was done for the acquisition of Ac. 3.18 acre of private land for land bank filling by IDCO, Bhubaneswar for Eastern Alloys Pvt. Ltd. for expansion of industry in the Goibhanga village, Lathikata Block, Lathikata Tahasil under Sundargarh District.

1. Industries are essential components of societal development which provides finished products to the market and jobs to a number of persons. The company needs to set-up new furnaces for enhancing production capacity. This is necessary for the growth of the industry as well as the development of the state. On expansion of the Industry, it will provide more number of employments to the people of the locality villages directly or indirectly. The project will considerable enhance the economic status of the General Public. Hence the project has a genuine Public Purpose.
 2. By acquiring Pvt. Land for expansion of industrial activities, the land holders will lose their land, noise pollution may arise and the present way of life of the people of the locality will affect. To mitigate their discomfort, Sarpanch told that the company should provide some basic facilities like construction of roads, digging of tube wells, construction of drainage on the road side and plantation in the village which should be provided by the project proponent. The project will extend more benefits to the people of the affected area as well as to the state. Hence, potential benefits outweigh the social costs and adverse social impact.
 3. The Industry has applied for an area of Ac.3.180 for its expansion which may consider not a large area for Industrial activities of an Industry which is the minimum area of land proposed to be acquired.
 4. As per available information there is no left out area from the previously acquired land in the area.
 5. There is no any acquired land lying un-utilized in the area.
- The committee discussed on the justification of acquisition of Ac. 3.18 of private land in the village of Goibhanga. All the members present gave their opinion in favour of acquisition of Ac. 3.18 acre of






The meeting ended with a vote of thanks offered by Sub-Collector, Sundargarh.





